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Maha Awas Abhiyan-Gramin Review Meeting by Video Conferencing of Hon. Minister, Rural Development

A review meeting of Maha Awas Abhiyan-Gramin was held on March 18, 2021 through video conferencing under the chairmanship of Hon. Minister, Rural Development Shri. Hasan Mushrif and In the presence of Hon. Additional Chief Secretary, Rural Development and Panchayat Raj Department Shri. Rajesh Kumar.

The meeting was attended by the Director of State Management Unit-Rural Housing Office, Dr. Rajaram Dighe, Deputy Director Shri. Nilesh Kale, Deputy Director Smt. Manjiri Takle, Assistant Director (Accounts) Shri. Santosh Bhand and State Management Unit officials are present.Chief Executive Officers of all Zilla Parishads, Project Director of District Rural Development Agency, Dy. Chief Executive Officer (Panchayat/MNREGA/Water and Sanitation) and Block Development Officers of all Panchayat Samiti were present through video conferencing.

At the beginning of this meeting Dr.Rajaram Dighe reviewed the progress of the campaign. The Hon. Minister instructed the Chief Executive Officer of Amravati District to focus on Gharkul schemes. Similarly, the districts which have not yet sanctioned the house work, have instructed all the attendees to complete the sanction process by March 31, 2021. He clarified that action would

be taken against the officers who delayed the work during the campaign period. The campaign was launched to provide shelter to the extremely poor. The success of the campaign depends on the cooperation of all the officers, hard work and goodwill towards the poor. An appeal was made to all attendees to cooperate for the success of the campaign.

In this Meeting Hon. Additional Chief Secretary, Rural Development and Panchayat Raj Department Shri. Rajesh Kumar instructed the CEO present at the meeting that they should focus on the activities of the campaign and build as many houses as possible during the campaign period. For this the Chief Executive Officer should hold regular meetings with the Project Director and Block Development Officer. The target of house building per day should be fixed till 31st March and it should be monitored accordingly. There is a discrepancy in the statistics given by the



districts in the meeting. Suggestion that this discrepancy should be rectified today. Additional Chief Secretary, Rural Development and Panchayat Raj Department gave the information to the attendees, the availability of land related to the revenue department, sand availability, regularization of encroachment and reward letter will be discussed with the revenue department, Additional Chief Secretary, Rural Development and Panchayat Raj Department addressed the gathering.

Meeting with the Department of Water Supply and Sanitation to discuss the action plan

Gharkul beneficiaries are given the benefit of various government schemes in collaboration with various government departments. For this a 02nd March, meeting was held on 2021 in the Director, State Management Unit-Rural Housing office regarding Water Supply and Sanitation from the department of Jal Jeevan Mission and Swachh Bharat Mission (Grameen) schemes. The meeting was attended by the Director of State Management Unit-Rural Housing Office, Dr. Rajaram Dighe, the Director of Water and Sanitation Support Organisation Mr. Rahul Sakore, State Management Unit Assistant Accounts officer, Mr. Sanjay Ghogle and Training Coordinator (IEC) Shri. In the meeting discussed the issue of giving tap drinking water to the household beneficiaries from Jal Jeevan Mission and giving priority to personal

He also discussed with the convener of the Water and Sanitation Support Organisation about the need to inform the concerned Block and District level system about the connection of household beneficiaries to get tap connection and toilet. Due to this meeting, the beneficiaries of the scheme from Water Supply and Sanitation Department will definitely benefit the households, said Shri. Rahul Sakore.

Review of rural mason training through video conference

The Director, State Management Unit - Rural Housing took a review of Mason Training organizations via VC On 01.03.2021, 09.03.2021, 15.03.2021 and 2.03.2021, The meeting was attended by the Deputy Director, Assistant Director (Accounts, Executive Engineer, Training Coordinator and Data Entry Operator) of the State

Management Unit.

At the beginning of the meeting, the Director of the State Management Unit-Rural Housing Office, Dr. Rajaram Dighe asserted on the progress of the work in the field of housing should be not only quantitative but also qualitative and innovative ideas should be embraced to provide the houses to all

the beneficiaries, and he instructed to all the staff of the Rural Mason Training institutes the to build the houses capable of dealing with natural calamities.

Maha Awas Abhiyan Gramin is being implemented effectively in the state. He insisted to complete the Mason training during this campaign period and insisted on evaluation of the trained Masons through CSDCI after completion of rural bricklayer training and asked to pay the assessment fees to CSDCI and Assured that the assessment fees will be reimbursed to them.

The information of the only

successful trainees is being filled on the Awaasoft system, this is also having a big impact on the overall progress of masonry training. He said that the failed trained needs to be re-evaluated which will help in overall progress of the programme.



Meeting chaired by Hon. Additional Chief Secretary, Revenue Department

Under the chairmanship of Hon'ble Additional Chief Secretary, Revenue Department in the presence of Additional Chief Secretary, Rural Development and Panchayat Raj Department a meeting was held on 26.03.2021 to discuss the issues regarding the Land of rural housing schemes and other issues related to the revenue department of housing schemes.

The meeting was attended by the Director of State Management Unit-Rural Housing, Dr. Rajaram Dighe, Section Officers of Revenue and Forest Department and other concerned officers were present.

In this meeting to waive the fee for purchasing Land under the scheme as the household beneficiary is poor. Waiver of Land enumeration charges when purchasing Land. Due to fragmentation law, 500 sq.ft. Land cannot be purchased, so eligible clauses under the scheme should decern the condition of fragmentation law when purchasing land. Exemption of Land Devolution and Devolution charges under the scheme. Approval of prize letter or notary deed instead of purchase deed for area within 10 Gunthas or required area for purchase of land under

rural housing scheme.

To inform the District Collector about the effective implementation of the government Resolution dated 02.08.2018 regarding making government land free of cost to the beneficiaries of rural housing schemes. To regularize encroachments outside the village and on the premises of various government department. Exemption of registration fee, stamp duty and enumeration in respect of land made available to household beneficiaries through prize letter or donation letter by NGOs and private individuals. To provide sand non-royalty up to 5 bras for construction of houses for the beneficiaries by retaining sand for construction of houses under Gramin Awaas Yojana. These topics were discussed.



Collaboration Meeting between State Management Unit -Rural Housing and Engineering College, Pune

Various Rural Housing Schemes are implemented through State Management unit-Rural Housing Office. Similarly, College of Engineering, Pune a reputed engineering institute having a reputation of producing quality engineers every year. These engineers work in various companies as interns. Meeting was held on 22.03.2021 at the College of Engineering, Pune, to take decision on collaboration of the State Management unit - Rural Housing and collage of Engineering Pune, for use of the technical and modern technology for the rural housing.
